



ADULT COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

TROOP 15 – APRIL 2009

1. At the District Awards Banquet on April 16, 2009, Mack Patterson was honored with a Lifetime Achievement Award and Sam Phifer with the Troop's Godsend Award.
2. TeamPower was well attended - 50 Scouts and 18 Adults. The Troop camped at the same camp site that will be used by the Troop during Summer Camp at Daniel Boone.
3. The next outing is a fishing trip the weekend of May 29, 2009. Jeff Greene will be the fishing merit badge counselor. Jeff will work on fishing skills with the Scouts at the Troop Meetings before the outing and during the Merit Badge Workshop on May 16, 2009.
4. The Boundary Waters trip currently has 16 going consisting of 9 Scouts and 7 Adults. Shakedown are being planned. A BBQ fundraiser is planned for late May, early June.
5. John Gergel is making arrangements for the Merit Badge Counselor training class to be taught at the Troop's Merit Badge Workshop on May 16, 2009.
6. A general discussion was held regarding the BSA policy that all adults who are driving to an outing must be listed on the Tour Permit for that outing. The general cut-off date for sign-ups is the Troop Meeting before the outing. If an adult is not listed on the Tour Permit and still drives to the outing he does so at his own risk and liability. Also the Scouts' health forms must be taken with the Troop so that they are readily available if an emergency should occur during the outing.
7. A hardcopy of the Troop Roster is available to adults at the Troop Meetings upon request by that adult. Any adult can request that their personal information, such as cell phone numbers and email addresses, not be distributed.
8. It was suggested the Scout's health forms be scanned into a database. The ACM decided not to scan the health forms because of potential privacy concerns and in case of an emergency the hardcopies would be easier to use and locate.
9. All adults are reminded to send or give Jeff Jancula their digital pictures so he can load them on to the Troop's website.
10. No Adult Committee Meeting is scheduled in May.
