



ADULT COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

TROOP 15 – JUNE 2009

1. Erich Jegier is the new Senior Patrol Leader. A JLT is scheduled for June 5 & 6, 2009.
2. The fishing outing was attended by 19 Scouts. The Troop will probably not use the same outfitter since there was not enough fishing poles made available and the campsite was just ok. The Scouts only caught a few fish but they were able to do some cooking since the outfitter did supply additional fish for their meal.
3. The next Troop outing is at the Whitewater Center on Wednesday, 7/15/09. The trip is scheduled on a weekday since the rates are much lower than on the weekends. The deadline to sign-up is by the Troop Meeting on 6/29/09. This will be a firm deadline since if there is not enough interest by the Scouts, or enough Adult leadership to attend during the week, then the trip will be postponed or cancelled. Sam Phifer will be sending -out additional details.
4. Summer Camp planning is going well. There is a total of 61 Scouts and Adults attending. Follow-up emails have been sent by the Summer Camp Committee to the folks who still need to get money or health forms turned-in. Arrangements have been made for transportation of the Scouts and Trailer. Keith Herron is organizing the Scouts regarding the loading of the Trailer and providing lunch to meet the Emergency Prep merit badge requirements. It was emphasized the Scouts must stay hydrated at Summer Camp and the Troop will provide ample water and Gatorade.
5. John Trainor continues to work with the outfitter regarding the Boundary Waters trip. He indicated the airline tickets have now been purchased. Mike Brians is the Leader for the Troop on the Boundary Waters trip. He is currently preparing the National Tour Permit. It was emphasized each crew needs to have an adult certified in CPR and preferably Wilderness First Aid. Pat Salley is copying the Health Forms to take on the trip. The Scouts will start selling BBQ this weekend to help raise money for the trip. It is anticipated each Scout will make \$5 per pound of BBQ he sells. Steve Jegier is overseeing the collection and allocation of the money raised.
6. A review of the Troop's finances was made. A copy of the financial report is available from John Trainor or Scott Bayne.
7. The Council has decided to not conduct on-site training for Merit Badge Counselors as had been discussed in the past. Every Merit Badge Counselor is encouraged to review the Council's website for times/dates it will offer the required training.
8. Scouts are encouraged to attend SEALS training at Belk Scout Camp on November 13-15, 2009.
